- * Build anticipation! Make sure the students and staff know that Kevin will be at their school and why.
- * Our hope is that Kevin's visit is more than just a "one-day experience" for the students. Instead, make his visit a part of the whole experience. Before Kevin arrives, have lots of fun with poetry, music, and writing.
